The materials cover many topics pertaining to welfare and poverty at the local, state, and federal level.

The collection contains materials relating to the social activism projects, its arrangement of administrative files, legislative and lobbying, news clippings, welfare reform campaigns, publication and reports, and research and subject files. The collection contains materials from 1979 to 2003. However the bulk of the materials are from the mid- 1980s to the early 2000s.
