The organization was a committee of the Albany Social Justice Center and met monthly for several years, and organized an annual dinner.

The majority of the collection are newsletters from national and international Palestinian support organizations, representing both the human rights perspective and Marxist-revolutionary perspective. The collection also includes photocopies of newspaper articles, campaign notes, meeting registries, and other typescript pages.

The collection provides a timely snapshot of the issues for international Palestinian support organizations after the fall of the Soviet Union. There is only one copy of the organization's own newsletter from 1991.
