Biographical History

Joseph Walders (1948-1992) was a writer and television producer. He wrote and produced the science television news reports for the "Mr. Wizard's World" program on Nickelodeon for 11 years. He was the author of *The World's Most Challenging TV Quiz* (1977) and also wrote articles for *TV Guide*, *Popular Science*, and *Science Digest*.

Walders received his bachelor's degree in radio and television from Syracuse University in 1971. Born in Pennsylvania, he lived in Los Angeles for many years before moving to Troy, New York.

Scope and Contents

This collection includes 151 television and film scripts, many with shooting schedules, and hand-written revisions, deletions, and annotations, 1952-1977; and 46 movie posters, 78 still photographs, 39 lobby cards, and 4 pressbooks for 68 films, many of them produced by George Pal or directed by Alfred Hitchcock, 1952-1977, all collected by Joseph Walders. Emphasis is on science fiction, fantasy, adventure, light comedy, mystery, and intrigue. *Alfred Hitchcock Presents*, *The Fugitive*, *I Spy*, *The Invaders*, and *Science Fiction Theatre* comprise two-thirds of the scripts collected by Walders.
