## Administrative History

New York Environmental News (NYEN) first began publishing in 1973 as a weekly publication under the editorship of Rosemary Nichols, a university professor affiliated with the Environmental Studies program. Starting with its third volume, the newsletter changed to a biweekly format. The fifth edition of the newsletter in 1978 saw the newsletter come under the leadership of the Atmospheric Sciences Research Center. After 1985, the newsletter was published by the Office of University Relations. The newsletter contained information about environmental issues and legislation in New York State.
