(Bach—German—1685-1750)
(Liszt—Hungarian—1811-1886)
- Composed for Organ by Bach, arranged for Piano by Liszt

- (b) The Carman's Whistle.....*Byrd (English, 1543-1623)*
- In these subtle variations on a popular air for the virginal, William Byrd—one of music's towering giants, shows a keyboard style (clearly influenced by lute technique), wholly different from that of composers a hundred or more years later—Couperin, Bach, Handel, Scarlatti, etc.

- (c) Handelian Rhapsody.....*Cyril Scott (English, 1897)*
- Cyril Scott (of whom Eugene Goossens has said: modern English music began with Cyril Scott) called his rhapsody "Handelian" because he felt its straightforward, major-scale delivery and sunny mood have something in common with Handel. This single movement carries a wealth of pithy themes and melodies
