

The Executive Committee met at the Office of the Secretary of State, Nov. 23, 1850, at 4 P. M.

Present, Messrs. Morgan, Hawley, Austin & Campbell.

Mr. Morgan in the chair.

The minutes of the last meeting were read & approved.

Messrs. Campbell & Austin were appointed a committee to prepare the annual report.

Mr. Austin's resolutions proposed September 17, were then considered, amended & adopted as follows.

Resolved:

That the term of the Normal School, which began on the second Monday of November, continue nineteen weeks, & that the next term thereafter begin immediately at the close of the first term, & continue nineteen weeks.

Resolved:

That hereafter the terms be fixed as follows.

The Fall Term to begin on the third Monday in September, & continue twenty one weeks, including an intermission of one week from Christmas to New Year's day.

The Spring Term to begin on the ^{last} Monday in February & continue twenty weeks;
