A special meeting of the Executive Com-
mittee was held at the office of the Su-
perintendent of Public Instruction.

Mr. Ogden of Ogden and Wright, ar-

chitects, was present by request, and explained the necessity of making immediate arrangements for iron girders and columns for the basement of the Normal School building, in accordance with the plans.

Bids for this iron work were then opened and considered, as follows:

Sullivan & Ehlers	426.25

On motion of Mr. Fryer the contract was awarded to the lowest bidder, Messrs Sullivan and Ehlers at \$426.25, and it was ordered that a contract in due form be executed with them.

On motion of Mr. Draper the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

Resolved, that the thanks of the Executive Committee of the Normal School be tendered to the Board of Education of the City of Albany for its courtesy in granting the use of the High School Building for a meeting of the Alumni of the school on the 27th of December last.

A communication was received from the President containing a list of the members of the graduating class recommended by the faculty for the diploma of the school to be granted at the closing exercises on January 25, 1884. On motion of Mr. Murray the list was approved, and ordered to be entered in the minutes.

The Committee then adjourned to meet at the call of the Secretary for the purpose of executing the contract for the iron work.
