

Minutes of Meeting held Monday, June 8th, 1908, at 3:30 P. M.

The meeting came to order promptly in the office of the Commissioner of Education, Chairman Draper in the chair and all members present.

The minutes of previous meeting were approved as read.

Commissioner Draper presented a communication from President Milne concerning appointments upon the faculty of the College for the next year, and after consideration the following resolutions were adopted:

RESOLVED, That President Milne be authorized to employ Barnard S. Bronson to teach chemistry at a salary of \$1200 per year; Adam Alexander Walker to teach the Science of Government and Economics at a salary of \$1200 per year, and David Hutchison to teach history at a salary of \$1500 per year. Also,

RESOLVED, That he be authorized to employ Miss Mabel A. Bryce and Miss Elizabeth F. Shaver for work in the practice school, each at a salary of \$600 per year; also that he be authorized to re-employ Miss Doyle, Miss Finney and Miss Phillip for the ensuing year, each at a salary of \$600. Also,

RESOLVED, That the employment of the persons named be for the coming school year only, and that they be so advised. Also,

RESOLVED, That Mr. H. Birchenough, Mr. C. A. Woodard, Miss Loeb, Miss Clement and Miss Cook be each given an increase in salary of \$100 per year.

On Motion it was resolved that Mr. Finegan be requested on the part of this committee to take what steps are necessary to secure the repavement of Washington Avenue at the rear of the new College buildings.

Mr. Finegan offered the following:

RESOLVED that the action of the building committee in authorizing the State Architect to prepare plans and specifications for iron staircases in the east and west ends of the main college building in accordance with scheme A and sketch

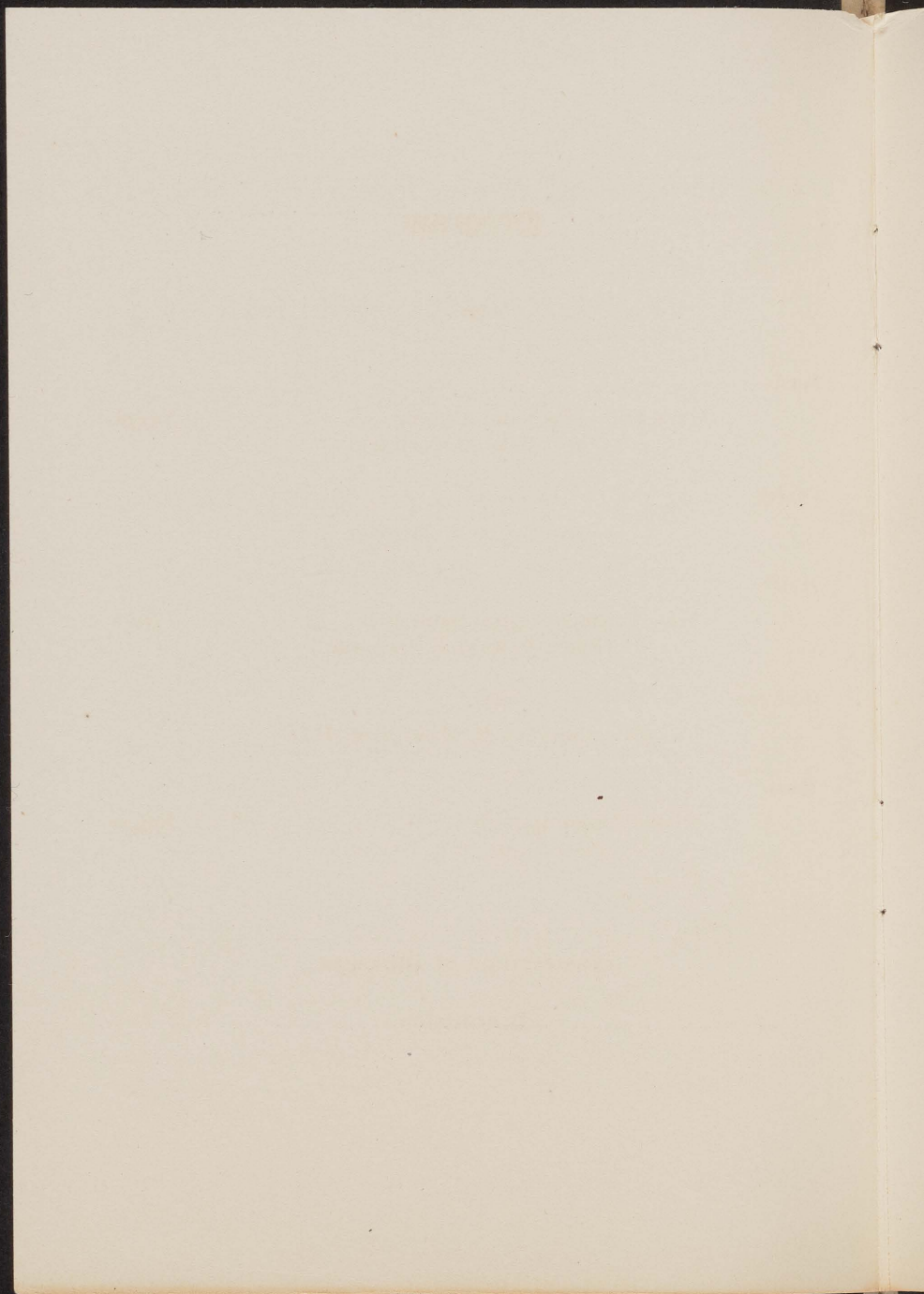

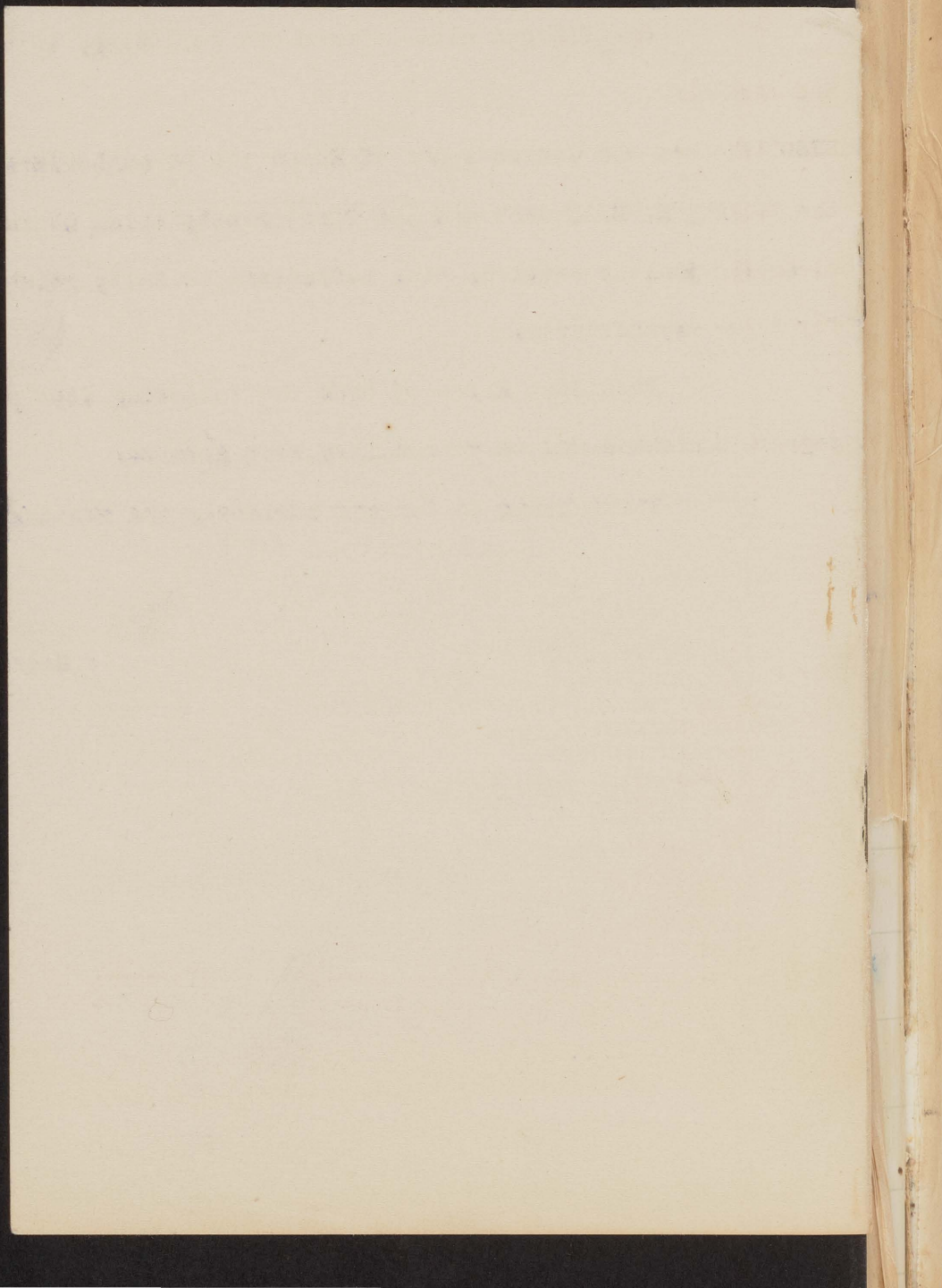

Stephens Co. in the sum of \$2399.60 for the construction of such staircases and in also authorizing special orders in the sum of \$10 for installing a ladder to the top of the chimney stack, in the sum of \$4.00 for changes in the fixtures and circuits in the auditorium and in the sum of \$16.50 for conduit for bell system to be operated on either side of the stage, be and the same is hereby ratified and approved by this board. The resolution was passed unanimously.

Mr. Finegan also offered the following, which was duly seconded and carried:

RESOLVE that the Commissioner of Education be authorized to audit claims from the Trinity M. E. Church and the First Presbyterian Church for light, heat, cleaning, janitor service, etc. sufficient to fully reimburse such churches for these expenditures. *
