RESOLVEI, That Mr. H. Birchenough, Mr. C. A. Woodard, Miss Loeb, Miss Clement and Miss Cook be each given an increase in salary of \$100 per year.

On Motion it was resolved that Mr, Finegan be requested on the part of this committee to take what steps are necessary to secure the repavement of Washington Avenue at the rear of the new College buildings.




