The one year guarantee period on our Accelerator Building has expired, so inspection was held this morning to observe whether or not we may sign off on this structure. The inspection was attended by representatives of the Construction Fund, the architect's field office, the contractor and myself representing the University.

This building was one of the better built ones on the new campus and our inspection this morning indicated that full compliance with structural requirements have been met. The building is apparently functionally as intended, and the staff that has occupied it for slightly more than a year have no complaints to make regarding the structure.

In view of the above, the contractor is cleared of all responsibility, full payment will now be made, and complete maintenance of the facility will now become the responsibility of the University and into the future.
