1. Another step was taken on July 14 toward the acquisition of the 40 acres on the northwest corner of the campus. This step was the allocation of \$1700. to cover the expenses for a contract with Gilson and Sales for the conduct of the abstract work, appraisals and surveys for the acquisition of this property.
2. Invitations for bids have been circulated for planting of the new campus in the vicinity of the main entrance on Washington Avenue, eastern portion and northern portion as far as the main entrance to Washington Avenue. This will be a mixture of maple, birch, aspen, pine and oak trees. Bids are due on the 6th of August and the contract will be let soon thereafter. The completion of this portion of the planting will assist in date control.
