

Joseph E. Trimble Award for Distinguished Contributions to Native and Indigenous Psychology. This award was created in honor of the significant contributions made by Joseph E. Trimble in Native and indigenous psychology, as well as his contributions toward making psychology responsive and relevant to the needs of Native and indigenous communities. Candidates for this award should demonstrate significant contributions to Native and indigenous psychology.

Two awards will be given. One award will be given to a promising graduate student who has demonstrated a commitment to achieving an admirable balance between community development and potential leadership in the field of psychology. The other award will be given to a senior level contributor to the field of Native and indigenous psychology who inspired their former students to create benefits for indigenous communities through their scholarship, practices, and leadership. Small stipends accompany the awards.
