Mr. Van Rensselaer moved that the Committee take steps to purchase from the owner, Mrs. Antemann, the house next adjoining the college building on the South, and known as no. 98 Willett St., for a sum not exceeding nine thousand dollars (\$9,000.) Carried.

Mr. Allen moved that Mr. Edward W. Rankin be employed to examine and attend to the transfer of the title of the house no. 98 Willett St. Carried.

Mr. Van Rensselaer moved that Dr. Miché be requested to ascertain the price of so much of the lot no. 455 Madison Ave. as would be required to straighten up our South line. Carried.
