The Resignation of Mr Felt as a Teacher in
the Normal School was presented & on motion,
the same was accepted.

On the nomination of the Principal

Mr Devotion Wood

was appointed a Tutor in the room of

W Felt, at a permanent salary of five hundred dollars.

An application of W Kellogg for an increase of salary was ordered to lie on the table.

The Committee appointed on the 26th January last relative to Professor Carr & Mr Dakin reported in favour of the appointment of Professor Carr to the Professorship of Natural Sciences, with a salary of one thousand dollars per annum, which was unanimously agreed to.
Resolved that the Secretary notify Professor Carr of his appointment.

Mr Sumner C. Webb, asked for temporary leave of absence for about two thirds of the ensuing term, for the purpose of attending Medical lectures & with the understanding that the other teachers would attend ~~his~~ classes, but the Committee apprehending that due justice, under such an arrangement, could not be done to the pupils, declined to sanction the same.

On Motion

Resolved, that D'Beck, W Sommers & Mr Woolworth be a Committee to present at the next meeting a permanent scale of Salaries, to which the Teachers as well as the Committee will consider themselves bound to adhere.
