Construction and Installation of New Somat System in Campus Center

Yesterday we inspected and accepted the construction covering the installation of the new disposal system in the Campus Center. Inspection and tests showed that this system works in a completely satisfactory manner and all provisions of the contract had been met.

Accomplishment of this job should vastly improve the disposal of all garbage developed within the Campus Center except for metal objects, glass and plastic. The high feature, of course, is the elimination of the disagreeable odors associated with the wet garbage disposal under the prior system. The job was completed within a few days after the contract completion date. This delay was legitimate and was occasioned by difficulties in the delivery of all of the disposal machines. Accomplishment of the work should not only facilitate cleanup within the kitchen, but should make the entrance into the Campus Center from the Service Tunnel a sweeter smelling place.

Food Service personnel should be cautioned not to use the disposals for metal, glass or plastic.
