CORNING UNIVERSITY REPORT NO. 12

At an emergency inspection this morning, we took over the main kitchen, dining hall and snack bar dining hall, plus mechanical equipment rooms and some associated refrigerators and storerooms pertaining to the main kitchen of the Campus Center. These areas can now be organized and arranged for food service to commence whenever those responsible care to start the service.

This completes the takeover of the basement floor of the Campus Center, except for the snack bar serving line itself, and bowling alley. In the snack bar serving line, the mechanical equipment had been so recently installed that it had not yet been demonstrated. Some of it had not been connected and in general, was not operable. Therefore, we did not take it over. Progress looks as though this may be completed in about a week.

In the bowling alley, even though we have not officially taken the area, the installation of the bowling alley equipment has been under way for several weeks and is about 60% complete.
