This, in brief, dear unther, is why:

- 1. From a formal-aesthetic viewpoint, the handwriting conjures up the rounded benty of Latin Bibles not later than the 10th century A. D., and when looked at upside down reminds of elaborately flourished and yet chaste medieval manuscripts in Arabic.
- 2. Psychographologically, the total impression is one of what might be called the paradox of secretive showmanship. The features exhibited in the grand style and with almost unbelievable poise are intended, though not by conscious will, to hide frightful and thus inhibitive daydreamings and phantasies.

Aestetic and psychological attraction combines to make the green script well-nigh fascinating to me,
