The bids were accordingly opened and are as follows:

On motion of Mr. Draper the contract was awarded to Messrs Sullivan & Shiers at \$1246⁴⁴ and the architect was requested to prepare a contract for said iron work to be executed by Sullivan & Shiers.

The Architect was authorized to change the plan of the building in two particulars, viz. to omit a wall & cover up an outer door connected with the ladies' cloak room; and second to prepare the wall between the

cloak room of the male students of the normal and noble departments; provided in either case no additional expense be incurred.
