SUBJECT: Rampus Progress Report No. 182

Today we inspected and accepted the basements of units C-D and E-F in the Indian Quadrangle, together with the entire service tunnel. We already have accepted the basements of A-B units. This gives us beneficial occupancy of all of the low-rises, except a portion of the basements in units G-H, which don't look as though they will be ready for several weeks.

The acceptance of the above-mentioned areas will enable the students living on the Indian Quad to have much more freedom of action and better accommodations, which in turn should make for better morale. The basements comprise mainly meeting rooms, music listening rooms, television rooms, luggage rooms, laundry rooms and linen rooms. This will also facilitate the installation of tie-in lines for the radio station WSUN.

Maintenance of the above-mentioned areas will henceforward become the responsibility of the University and by information copy of this memorandum, the principals so involved are being informed.
