Pursuant to call the meeting came to order promptly in the directors room of the State National Bank on State St., present Messrs. Van Rensselaer, who on motion took the chair, and Messrs. Pray, Cogswell and Ward. Dr. Miller was also present by invitation.

The Treasurer stated that by reason of the unusual sum of about four thousand dollars having been expended this year for repairs there was not enough money in the treasury to meet the salaries of the President and janitors which would fall due during the summer vacation, but that every other bill for the fiscal year which had been presented had been paid in full.

Mr. Pray moved that the Treasurer be authorized and instructed to borrow from the Commercial Bank the sum of eleven hundred dollars (\$1100.) with which to pay these salaries. The motion was seconded by Mr. Cogswell and carried.

The motion the meeting adjourned.
