The campus acted locally to suspend promotion and admissions for these programs beginning in September 2009. We anticipate that approximately 30 matriculated students who were admitted to the M.A. prior to the academic year 2009-10 will finish the program, withdraw, or transfer to the M.P.A. program by August 2014. Leaving a year for unexpected delays, we anticipate seeking formal discontinuance of the nine programs effective August 2015.

Our transition away from the M.A. in Public Affairs and Policy has been fully considered and approved through our campus governance system. We are appreciative for anticipated efforts by staff in your Office of Program Review for the consideration and processing of this request.
