

Minutes of Meeting held Monday, June 10th, 1907, at 10:00 A. M.

The meeting came to order promptly in the office of the Commissioner of Education, Chairman Draper in the chair, and all members present

The minutes of previous meeting were approved as read.

Mr. Robert D. Macpherson and Mr. Samuel Manning, representing the State Architect's Office, were present and presented blueprints showing the proposed location of the new College ^{buildings} on the surface of the ground.

It was moved, seconded and carried that the recommendation of Mr. Ross and the State Architect, that the level for the grounds of 229 feet above datum, be adopted.

It was also moved that the boiler-house be located in the north-west corner of the site and that it be kept as low as compatible with utility. ^{Motion carried.}

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
