The subject of a supply of coal for keeping the new building warm during its construction, and the extent of the responsibility of the committee for preparing the supply, was referred to the Pricing Committee with power.

On motion of Mr. Cropper the Pricing Committee was authorized to arrange to have a plan laid in the attic of the Laboratory and the attic of the South Stacks, the same being in addition to the contract for carpenter's work.

The committee appointed Jan. 6, to appear before the Commissioners of the Land Office in reference to the sale of the 180 acres of land being sold during the winter & that a hearing be referred to a committee consisting of the Comptroller and Treasurer. With reference to the action of the committee there authorized.
