Business:

The Council reviewed the policy regarding the retention and use of the "Violation of Academic Integrity Reports". It was noted that the files are retained in the Office of the Vice Provost for Undergraduate Education or Graduate Studies (as appropriate) during the time that the student is an active student at the University at Albany. The policy states that, "Upon graduation or separation of the student from the University, these confidential reports will be destroyed." Current practice has not included the destruction of the files. Conversation ensued about the purpose of the files and if they should be utilized as official records when reporting to outside agencies or institutions. Additionally, concern was expressed about how students were made aware that such a report was submitted and what steps they could take to appeal. It was concluded that additional information was needed about the purpose of the files and the procedures in place to ensure student awareness of reports and opportunity to appeal.

It was suggested that changes to the submission form could address a number of these issues.
