The meeting came to order promptly, present Messrs. Pruyn, Logswell and Ward, and Pres. Milne by invitation. In the absence of Deft. Skinner, Mr. Pruyn, on motion, took the chair.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.

Dr. Milne stated that Deft. Skinner had asked to have this meeting called for the purpose of purchasing the lot of ground and building upon it, no. 102 Nillebt St., at present the property of the estate of the late Isaac May.

Mr. Logswell moved that Mr. Skinner, the Pres. of this Executive Committee be authorized to purchase this property, after the approval of the title by the Attorney General, for the sum of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000.-) and be requested to draw a warrant on the State Comptroller for this sum for this purpose.

The motion was duly seconded and carried.

The Secy. moved that Pres. Milne be requested to obtain from Mrs. Barbara Thoren an option until April 1, 1903, on the property no. 100 Nillebt St., for the sum of twelve thousand dollars, (\$12,000.). Carried.

Pres. Milne reported that he had collected ninety-one dollars and twenty-five cents (\$91.25) of over-due tuition-fes.

Mr. Logswell moved that Pres. Milne be authorized to bring suit hereafter for any over-due tuition-fes at his own discretion. Carried.

Mr. Logswell moved that the issue of diplomas at the

Commencement of June 14, 1901, be and hereby is approved. Carried.

Mr. Cogswell moved that diplomas be granted to the persons on the list hereto appended, some on Feby. 4, 1902, and the remainder to be granted on June 13, 1902, all after satisfactory examinations passed and having been duly recommended by the Pres. and Faculty. Carried.

Dr. Milne stated that for a long time past the janitors had spent so much time attending to sales at their book and stationery stand that in January last he felt obliged to abolish this custom, thus cutting off quite a considerable sum from their perquisites. After free discussion of the matter, Mr. Cogswell moved that after Aug. 1, 1902, the janitors be each paid seventy dollars (\$70.) per month. Carried.

Dr. Wood moved that janitor Elias Northman be permitted to occupy rooms not required for college purposes in the house no. 102 Willlet St., on conditions to be arranged by President Milne. Carried.

Mr. Cogswell moved that Mr. J. L. Merriam be granted leave of absence for one year more, to continue his studies at Harvard University, and that Mr. Wm B. Aspinwall be granted leave of absence for next year to pursue his studies at the University of France. Carried.

Mr. Cogswell moved that the salary of Miss Emilee A. ^(Perine) Perine be increased from six hundred (\$600.) to eight hundred dollars (\$800.) Carried.

The Secretary moved that the salary of Miss Amelia Hyde be increased from six hundred (\$600.) to seven hundred dollars (\$700.). Carried.

The Secretary moved that Pres. Milne be authorized to select

some one of the Faculty to act as his Secretary, at a sum not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.) a year. Carried.
