The provisions of the contract were satisfactorily performed, subject to a punch list which was very small. The existence of damageed signs in certain locations about the campus could not be held against the contractor.

as these were damaged by other vehicular traffic and/or snow plows over the past winter. The correction of these deficiencies, if they are to be corrected, will be a responsibility of the University.

Today we also inspected and accepted the construction work in the East and West Podium Courts for the end of the one year guarantee period. These courts stood up very well during the past year, especially during the severe winter, and apart from a small recaulking job on one joint, were considered for final acceptance.
