

Second bachelor's degree

Admission

Applicants for a second bachelor's degree should apply directly to the department they will be majoring in.

Degree Requirements

Major – Students must complete all requirements for the major to be awarded a second bachelor's degree, including residency requirements.

Minor – Students are not required to complete a minor in order to be awarded a second bachelor's degree.

General Education – Students are not required to complete the general education requirements, other than the upper-level writing course, in order to be awarded a second bachelor's degree.

Total number of credits – Students must complete at least 30 credits at the University at Albany in order to be awarded a second bachelor's degree.

Residency – Students must satisfy both the University residency requirements (30 of the last 60 credits completed on this campus) and the major residency requirements (18 credits in the major completed at Albany, of which 12 credits are upper level).

Degree

Students earning a second bachelor's degree are not eligible for "Latin" honors (*cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *summa cum laude*).
