the Secretary & Mr. Pinney were directed to
raise the rates of tuition.

The salaries of Professors Jones & St. John ✓
were fixed at £1800, for the six years ✓
& that of Miss. Fernand at £700. — ✓

The Secretary stated that with the
approval of the Chairman he had
had contracts with Mr. Warner to
extend the steam heating apparatus
through the building at an addition
of expense of five hundred dollars,
which was approved.

A communication from the President
in regard to the salaries of the teachers as
compared with those in other normal schools
was read. It was suggested that those of the
female teachers should be advanced to £900.

The subject was laid over for future con-
sideration. It was ordered that after the
present term the salary of Miss Fernand
be advanced to £800.

was submitted & adopted.

The Annual Report to the Superintendent
of Agents which had been approved & signed
by the individual members of the committee
was adopted.

It was ordered that an application
be made to the Legislature for an extra
appropriation of \$1000, for furniture
repair & ventilation.

nations will take effect at the close of the
present term the matter of a reorganization
of the school was discussed and a com-
munication on the subject from Dr. Alden
was read.

After some consideration the subject
was referred to the Chairman and
Secretary.
