RE: TEACHING AND PROFESSIONAL FACULTY SENATOR AT LARGE NOMINATIONS

The University Faculty Bylaws call for the Governance Council of the University Senate to prepare and distribute a preliminary slate of candidates for the election of Senators-at-large. This year two full-time Teaching Faculty and two full-time Professional Faculty need to be elected to two-year terms beginning next fall. The preliminary slates are printed at the end of this email.

The Bylaws stipulate that the "name of any eligible Faculty member who has been nominated by a petition of at least 25 faculty members, received at least 2 weeks before the election, must be added. The final slate will be published at least 1 week before the election, will include at least two candidates for each vacancy, and will indicate voting deadlines."

The election occurs at the Spring Faculty Meeting, Tuesday, April 22^{nd} (CC Ballroom, 2:30-4:00 pm). The deadline for submitting petitions to add a candidate is therefore close of business April 8^{th} . Petitions should be mailed to Dick Collier, Institutional Research, UAB 101.

Nominees must be full-time members of the Voting Faculty and must agree to be nominated and, if elected, to serve. University Senate meetings occur monthly from 3:30 to 5. Senators must also agree to be a member of one of the Senate's councils or standing committees.
