

Thursday, June 11, 1903.

4 P.M.

The meeting came to order promptly in the office of the Supt. of Public Instruction, present Supt. Skinner, in the chair, and Messrs. Pruyn and Ward, with Pres. Milne by invitation.

The minutes of the last meeting were approved as read.

Pres. Milne reported a list of names recommended for <sup>diplomas and</sup> degrees at the approaching Commencement, and on motion they were duly granted. The list will be found attached.

On motion of the Treasurer Messrs. Pruyn and Cogswell were appointed a committee to audit the Treasurer's accounts up to the close of the current year, July 31, 1903.

Mr. Pruyn moved that Supt. Skinner be authorized and empowered to complete the purchase of nos. 100 and 104 Willett St. for college purposes. Carried.

Mr. Pruyn moved that Pres. Milne be instructed to get an option of purchase of the property on the adjacent corner of Willett St. and Madison Ave. Carried.

On motion it was resolved that the rate of tuition to be hereafter charged in the High School department be left to the discretion of Pres. Milne.

On the recommendation of Mr. Milne, Mr. Ward moved that leave of absence for one year be granted to Prof. Great to enable him to attend a course for the degree of Ph.D. at Columbia University, and that Miss Ruth Stone be appointed to fill his place for that period at a salary of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.) Carried.

The motion it was resolved that Pres. Miller be empowered to make the changes and improvements in the buildings about to be purchased necessary to render them available for college uses, at an expense not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.).
