

Sept. 15, 1884.

The Executive Committee met  
pursuant to a call of the Chairman.  
Present: Supt. Ruggles,

The minutes of the last meeting  
were read and approved.

The committee appointed to take ac-  
tion in reference to the unpaid taxes  
on the lots purchased from Mr.  
Auston Adams reported that Mr. Draper  
had written to Mr. Adams but had  
received no response, that the Committee  
had consulted the Attorney General  
in reference to the collection of the taxes  
from Mr. Adams, and after a full  
consideration of the subject recommend-  
ed that ~~in~~ <sup>in</sup> view of the want of fi-  
nancial responsibility of Adams,  
the Treasurer be directed to pay the  
taxes for 1882, and hold the matter  
of the taxes for 1880 for the fur-  
ther consideration of the Execu-  
tive Committee.

On motion the recommendation



of the Committee was adopted and the Treasurer directed to pay the taxes due on lots 84 + 86 West Street for 1882.

Bills for the New Building were presented as follows: Patrick McCann for Carpenter work \$5000.<sup>00</sup>; Ogden & Wright Architects \$362.<sup>50</sup>. On motion the bills were audited at the amounts named and ordered paid.
