Dear President Philip:

I am writing in response to your April 8, and April 14 2011 letters proposing the deactivation of the list of programs appended to this letter.

The temporary suspension of admissions, or deactivation, of the programs listed on the following pages, effective May 3, 2011, is approved. The status of these programs will be noted accordingly on official university records. No new students may be admitted to these programs. The degrees will remain registered by the State Education Department and will therefore continue to be listed on SED's Inventory of Registered Programs.

The period of deactivation is limited to three years. By 2014, the campus must seek either program reinstatement (with revisions, as necessary) or formal discontinuance. Programs cannot be deactivated indefinitely.

As you know, the elimination of an academic program requires further review by the university. Should you decide to discontinue these programs, please use the Request to Deactivate and/or Discontinue a Program, which encompasses the procedure outlined in Memorandum to Presidents, Vol. 83 No.11. Please note, if you discontinue the multi-institution programs you will again need the signature of the chief academic officer at the partner intuition.
