CAMPUS PROGRESS REPORT #22

1. The color and texture of the wall panels on the Commissary has been the subject of development and discussion. Mr. Torgelson came to Albany for this question. Contractor prepared a panel by cleaning and the panel was inspected this week. It cleans up to a much superior appearance than when left untouched. Color and texture are both improved. It is now apparent that there is a high percentage of quartz in the aggregate, which, when cleaned gives a delicate pink color with a crystalline sparkle.
2. Most of the curbing for the large parking lot behind the Service Building has been installed.
3. The third and last story is being poured on the west wing of Dormitory No. 1.
4. Dam construction is continuing, and today, the steel sheathing was begun. Recent rains have already started to reconstitute our lake. The lake should reach full proportions by next Spring.
