Campus Progress Report No. 47

1. The new dam and surrounding landscaping was inspected and accepted today. It is the first formal acceptance of any portion of the new campus and was completed on time.
2. The first floor of the Biology building is being poured.
3. In Dormitory No. 1, plastering has started in the west wing.
4. Window panels have been erected in the dining hall and adjacent arcade region.
5. All windows have been glazed in all sections to be occupied in the first dormitory in September and the various trades work is in various stages of completion.
6. All columns have been capped on the west wing and forms have been erected to cap columns on the east wing.
7. The pouring on the sixth floor of the tower started yesterday. Side panels have been erected on the west portion of the north wing in Dormitory No. 1. Parking lot has been completed except for two bays. Turnout lanes have been completed on Washington Avenue, Western Avenue, and are now being constructed on Fuller Road.
