SUBJECT: Campus Progress Report No. 194 - Caulking of the Colonial Quad Tower

This morning we attended the opening of bids at Office of General Services (OGS) pertaining to this project. Six firms, mostly from New York State, submitted responsive bids, ranging from \$24,750 to \$99,999. The apparent low bidder was National Caulking and Restoration, Inc., of Albany, New York, at \$24,750.

At our request, the Central Office has already concurred in assignment of the contract to this firm, thereby saving two weeks of processing time. Unless unusual delays occur in other clearances, we should be able to start and finish this job during favorable weather this summer and early fall. This will give us an opportunity to observe the effect of these correctional steps and if they prove satisfactory, we can apply them as required to the Dutch and State Quadrangles, where similar work is needed.

The basic problem to be corrected here was water infiltration through faulty sealant, closing the openings between precast panels that form the exterior skin.

Sufficient money has been approved for this project and cleared by the Division of the Budget.
