The meeting was called to order at 2:04 p.m. by Chair Ronald Bosco.

Chair Bosco introduced Gloria DeSole, Secretary, and William Lanford, Vice Chair.

Chair Bosco stated that there was a single item of business: a need for action on the membership roster of Councils for next year (1989-90). The rosters come moved and seconded by the Executive Committee.

Chair Bosco stated that some Councils require a specific number of Senators to serve as members of the Council; about one-half of the elected Senators serve on Councils and the balance serve on Standing Committees.

In response to a question about the selection process for membership on Councils, the Chair noted that he sent two requests to the university community. This year there were two and one-half times more volunteers than positions on Councils.

The Executive Committee (R. Bosco, G. DeSole, W. Hammond, W. Lanford, P. Wallace) consulted with past chairs, and after taking into account the need for a fair distribution from all schools, colleges and disciplines, proposed the rosters for the Councils.

A motion to move the question was seconded; the Council rosters were approved unanimously.
