- 1. The first three penels constituting the walls of the Dormitory have been created on the west wing. They have the dark aggregate for background which makes a good contrast between the white ribs. The appearance is most satisfactory.
- 2. The third floor has been poured on the east wing, has been inclosed by tarpeulins and is undergoing the drying period while inclosed.
- 5. Some forms are being moved from the west wing to the north wing where they are making ready to pour the first floor.
