Look Repair, Uptown Campus Doraltory Towers

This morning an inspection of leak repair work at Dutch and Colonial Quad towars was conducted. The project included recaulking of procest well panel joints at Colonial, and elevator penthouse base flashing repair at Dutch. The former Item has corrected conditions which long plagued the resident students with both disconfort and instances of water damage to personal property. Checks made during the conduct of the lob indicated progressive improvement and completion of the work should signal the end of these problems.

The project was inspected by representatives of CGS, the SUNYA Department of Physical Plant and this office, and was found to be complete and satisfactory. A one year quarantee period on meterials and worksenship commences today.

The success of this project has convinced all concerned that the same corrections should be applied to the Dutch and State Quadrangle Towers. Preliminary drawings and specifications have already been prepared, reviewed and approved. We expect bids to be received in May and work to be completed In October.
