MTTHEW HAGGERTY, ALBANY (Fr, G, Wayland, Mass.) In just 16 minutes off the bench, had 11 points, three rebounds and two assists while shooting 4-7 (.571) field goals and 3-4 (.750) from three points range in an 88-78 win over Franklin Pierce.
