SUBJECT: Campus Progress Report No. 208 Repair of Sidewalks, Downtown Campus.

Last Wednesday an inspection was conducted of this project and this inspection showed that the job had been satisfac torily completed in all respects. The scope of the work included extensive sidewalk repairs all around the Draper complex and similar repairs, plus some new sidewalks in the area of the Alumni Quadrangle. The job was completed by Callanan Industries, inc., a firm that has done a great deal of work for us, was done in a most satisfactory manner, and was completed on schedule.

Work included the trimming of lawns adjacent to the concrete sidewalks and the planting of grass.

The weather was clear enough so that a good inspection was possible. However, our staff had made an inspection several weeks ago before the snow was on the ground. This preliminary inspection was the most meaningful and gave every indication of all contractural obligations having been met. These sidewalks now comply with all safety standards and vastly improve the appearance of our Downtown Campus. The price of the job was \$30,385.00.
