Replace and Relocate Emergency Exit Hardware - Colonial
Quadrangle

Yesterday we inspected and accepted without reservation the above project. Owing to problems beyond our control the job was completed about one month late. However, since it was not of a crucial nature the effects were not adverse.

The task consisted of moving emergency exit hardware from the exterior dormitory doors in the Colonial Quadrangle to the interior vestibule doors and to make certain other minor alterations. This permits students returning to their residences after hours when the doors are normally locked to take shelter in the vestibule while awaiting the unlocking of the vestibule doors. This is a feature which is highly important on a cold winter's night.

The job was well executed by Harold Lapham and Son of Albany, who was well ahead of his schedule but had to wait for delivery of the hardware since the suppliers were on strike. All four residence quadrangles now have this arrangement and it will add to the convenience and comfort of the students.
