CAMPUS PROGRESS REPORT NO. 55. Work situation Tuesday morning 4 May.

1. Moratorium was not adopted.
2. There is a work stoppage this morning on the Academic Complex, for all trades except the electricians and the pile drivers. Most electricians and pile drivers came to work but even so, there will be a slowdown on these trades.
3. There is a group of workmen at the gate with a law enforcement officer. Authorized persons are being permitted to enter, and formal picketing has not been established.
4. Work is continuing without letup on the dormitories since they are not affected by this dispute, inasmuch as these contractors are not members of the management group.
5. Work is also continuing with the landscaping.
6. The architect's manager on site predicts a settlement in about two days for the Academic complex.
