CAMPUS PROGRESS REPORT #19

1. The curbing along Madison Avenue Extension is being installed.

2. The first precast wall panels, which are scheduled to be installed on the Commissary, arrived yesterday from the plant in Massachusetts. The ribbing is white concrete, and the background closely resembles the multi-colored Matrix which we have in our sample. These pebbles are a mixture of light tan, dark tan, and some slightly pink and black.

3. Continuation of the pouring of roof on unit "A" of the Service Building. This will probably be completed this week.

4. The first rain we have had in a month, little though it was, has made a perceptible difference to the seeding of the athletic fields, which are now showing fairly green on the southern perimeter.

5. Footings have been poured for the high rise, and reinforced columns are now being placed atop these footings.
