

To Whom It May Concern:

We, the Advocating Against Racism Team (AART), will submit a brief, publishable summary of the findings from our study (Resisting Racism: Coping and Empowerment to Address Negative Effects on Mental Health) to the *Journal of Indigenous Research* for publication, with the understanding that the submission may be a summary of an article that we publish elsewhere and have authorization to submit. The summary will be written with non-technical language and will be between 1500 and 2000 words. Our study aims to understand experiences of racism, reactions and responses to these experiences, and racism's effect on psychological well-being for people of color. For the summary submitted to the *Journal of Indigenous Research*, we will particularly focus on the results from the subsample of participants who identify as Indigenous or multiracial Indigenous. It is our hope that the publication of this summary, in addition to the dissemination plan outlined above, will ensure that the results reach Indigenous communities and providers who work with members of Indigenous communities.
