SUBJECT: Campus Progress Report No. 76

Over this past weekend, the movement of the School of Social Welfare into Pierce Hall was completed. They are now in the process of settling in, and an inspection of the facility yesterday indicated that the processing is well-advanced. This also includes the incorporation of their segment of the library in the Ingle room, with the library for GSPA.

This now completes the occupation of Sayles and Pierce Halls by their new occupants. Classes were under way in both buildings on the Mondays following the respective moves.

An inspection was made on the remodeling in both of these Halls by myself, accompanied by Mr. John F. Buckhoff, Plant Superintendent and we have determined that the contractual obligations of Mr. Dobert, our contractor, have been satisfactorily completed, and payment is now due. I understand that the bill presented to Mr. Samuel Aronowitz resulted in nonpayment. Mr. Aronowitz is apparently waiting for his money from the State. A check with the Land Acquisition Office this morning indicates that this transaction is not likely to be completed and payment made in less than two months. Mr. Dobert will not want to wait that long for his money, and I believe there is a moral obligation on the part of the University to make a prompt payment some way or other. Perhaps Mr. Aronowitz could be persuaded to make the payment to Mr. Dobert prior to the receipt of his funds from the State.
