Chair's Report for SEC/Senate (January 2023)

- Proposed revisions to the General Education Program to be presented to University Senate on 2/8, originating as a proposal in the General Education Committee, a subcommittee of the UAC, which has been meeting (most recently on 1/17) and working on this effort since October 2022
- UAC met most recently on 1/19
 - o to vote on the GEC proposal, which was approved unanimously by UAC (and first by GEC), and sent to SEC for consideration as a bill to be introduced to Senate on 2/8
 - UAC heard from AVP for Academic Innovation Debra Gelinas on proposals for credit for prior learning, currently under consideration/question period
 - o received B.A./B.S. reregistration update from Kaitlyn Beachner, includes 4 proposals approved by UAC working groups in November
- Program Deactivations: UAC was notified of proposals from 2 academic departments to deactivate undergraduate programs with low enrollment, current students can complete
 - Religious Studies Concentration (housed in History as Interdisciplinary Studies)
 - Medieval and Renaissance Studies Concentration (housed in English as Interdisciplinary Studies)
 - Medieval and Renaissance Studies minor (housed in English)
- Committee on Academic Standing met several times in January to review reinstatement petitions from academically dismissed students.
- Interdisciplinary Studies Committee worked over break to approve 2 UUNI 390 petitions
- Curriculum and Honors and UAC member Erin Baker represents University Senate on the
 Academic Affairs Working Group of the CNSE and UAlbany Reunification effort
- In Nov., Dean of Undergraduate Education JoAnne Malatesta reported on UA's \$2.5 million
 HHMI (Howard Hughes Medical Institute) grant to diversify STEM faculty/professional pipeline
