The Executive Committee met in the office of Hon. J. F. Crooker, Supt. of Public Instruction, pursuant to call. Present, Mr. Crooker, in the chair, Messrs. Harris and Ward, and, by invitation Pres. Milne.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Dr. Milne presented a list of eighteen candidates for the degree of Bachelor of Pedagogy; of ninety - three for diplomas, as having completed the English course; and of eleven for having completed the kindergarten course. The motion these diplomas were ordered granted.

An motion it was resolved that the matter of purchasing coal for the ensuing year be left to Mr. Harris, in consultation with Pres. Milne.

An motion it was resolved that the President be authorized to spend in the purchase of books, for the library of the college, on the subject of pedagogy, a sum not to exceed one thousand dollars, providing that that amount remains in the treasury after all other bills for the current year shall have been provided for.
