SUBJECT: Campus Progress Report No. 168
Unit "C" (Mahican Hall - Indian Quadrangle).

An inspection was made today by the undersigned and representatives of the Dormitory Authority, the architect and the contractor. Mahican Hall was in a higher state of readiness than were the two previous units accepted last September. As a result of the inspection, beneficial occupancy was considered feasible, and the following parts of the building will be turned over to the University effective tomorrow, 23 December 1970:

1. First, Second and Third floors, excluding the lobby area and offices.
2. Secondary hot water heating system and automatic hot water system.
3. Electrical system and necessary power panels.

The acceptance, of course, was subject to a punch list, which has been given to the contractor for completion.

By earlier agreement, preliminary steps have been taken by the Plant Department to do a final cleaning of the occupied areas, and to move in furniture, all of which is on hand. Necessary fire provisions have been met and a limited number of telephones are being installed.

The above provisos will enable the residence people to honor their commitments to house all students who must remain on campus during the intersession in Mahican Hall, and will vastly simplify security, maintenance and cleaning problems during that period.

By information copy of this report, the Plant Department is notified that it has responsibilities from here on for the maintenance and operation of the aforementioned facilities.
