Peace Offerings Review of 1994

- StaffingStaffing hours were reduced from about 35/hrs a
   week in 1993 to 20/hrs a week from January to
   June and 25/hrs a week from June to Sept. In
   September we increased hours to 45 a week.
- We are currently at 25/hrs a week. Ruth is working 15/hrs and is responsible for all aspects of the store such as ordering, promotion, and recordkeeping. Kim is working 10/hrs a week and is responsible for all the daily finances and making sure the store is staffed.
- PromotionMost of the promotion for '94 was done in the fall and early winter. Ads were placed in the Coop Scoop, Holistic Guide, the Old Songs Program, Citizen Action Program Book, HHAANYS Program Book, Community Newsletter, WAMC, REEL Visions Program Book, BCHS Program, Metroland, and the Women's Building.
- In the fall we did two mailings to the Peace Offerings
  List and sent a Catalog to the entire SJC
  list. We helped organize a large event in
  November which raised \$2,000 for the Center.
  In August there was a Women of Color Poetry
  Reading, and CEC, and HAC had events at the
  store. We tabled at Clearwater and Old Songs
  last June.
- Finances:Our financial situation is better at the end of '94 than it was at the beginning of the year. We have a larger inventory and were able to pay off the loses of 1993. We raised less than we had hoped this year but our expenses were less so we ended up the year in good shape. Since October our sales have been consistently higher than the same months in 1993.
