SUBJECT: Campus Progress Report No. 79

At an acceptance inspection this morning, the following additional areas in the Colonial Quadrangle were taken over for beneficial occupancy:

The basement lounge connecting the Tower to the Dining Hall; the Laundry Room in the basement of the Tower and the Luggage Room; the Jan Room which opens off the Luggage Room, and the Elevator Corridor at the mezzanine level.

As soon as the washers and dryers are installed in the Laundry Room, these may be used by students and the Luggage Room is now ready for use. The luggage racks are in the process of being completed today.

The Plant Superintendent should take steps to have the washers and dryers installed as soon as possible, and to install fire extinguishers in their receptacles in the above mentioned areas.

The parking lot west of the Health and Physical Education building has been completed and turned over to us for occupancy by the contractor. This area could be used more conveniently for the parking of students in the residence to the extent that space allows. Parking space thus vacated in the parking lot south of the Health and Physical Education building will be used partially by the contractor who is still working on this building. The net effect of this swap will be to move about fifty of the student's cars closer to the residences than is now possible. Campus Security Guards should implement this parking rearrangement.

Topsoiling, seeding, mulching and tacking for dust control through the forthcoming winter will be resumed next week in the immediate vicinity of the Colonial Quadrangle. Cars that have been permitted to park in the space southeast of this Quad will have to be removed and parked elsewhere. About one-third of these cars belong to the construction workers working on Group II and the contractor will take steps to have them park on the Great Circle. The remainder of the cars bear student stickers, and parking of these cars should be restricted by Campus Security patrol, and redirected into their appropriate areas.
